THIS PLATFORM? Self-testing has become one of the most powerful strategies for increasing testing among the LGBTQ+ community. Through

BHOC's partnership with Emory University, we identified that 22% of gay/bi dating app users in the US had never tested for HIV. 77% of app users reported that they wanted to be able to order a home HIV test through a dating app. "MSM who use dating apps support new features to promote sexual health," 2018 STD Prevention conference, Washington DC."



HIV SELF-TESTS responsible for distributing over 343,000 HIV self-test kits in the US alone through TakeMeHome and our national partner program. Building on this success, we are expanding our model to distribute additional HIV test kits globally, with a particular

testing easier by identifying, vetting, and supporting in-country self-testing platforms. It expands self-testing services to include STI testing and PrEP labs in select global locations, thereby reducing barriers faced by many LGBTQ+ individuals.
